# School Profile 2019-2020

Founded by American educators and philanthropists in 1878, the American Collegiate Institute (ACI) is an independent, co-educational high school which prepares students for higher education in Turkey and abroad.

ACI's mission is to develop the personal, social and environmental responsibility of students who are bilingual in Turkish and English. ACI is committed to inspiring students to become life-long learners with the necessary skills, accountability, and attitudes required for leading a fulfilling life, and for serving their country and humanity. ACI is co-governed by a private Turkish charitable foundation known in Turkey as SEV. The same organization operates Üsküdar American Academy, Tarsus American College, and SEV American College.

ACI is fully accredited by and operates under the jurisdiction of the Turkish Ministry of Education. ACI was accredited by the European Council of International Schools (ECIS) in 1994 and receives continuing accreditation through the Council of International Schools (CIS.) ACI has been an International Baccalaureate World School since 2005.



# Curriculum

Our academic program follows a university preparatory curriculum with an intensive English focus. As bilingual scholars, our students learn to function effectively within two distinct teaching styles and cultures.

38-41 periods of instruction per week

50% of all class hours in grades 9-12 are taught in English

English is treated as a main course, and is also used to deliver instruction in mathematics and some science courses

All students take a full year of immersive English instruction during the mandatory preparatory year

English skills are assessed using the IELTS exam

All students must complete Turkish Lise Diploma (MEB) requirements

Turkish cultural subjects, including literature, social sciences, religion and psychology are taught in Turkish, according to national education regulation

Elective course offerings include art, music, physical education, French, German and Spanish

By graduation, students complete a demanding program averaging twelve courses per semester



### Academic Grading System

ACI does not report rank. GPA is calculated by weighting each subject according to the number of lessons per week. Grades are scored on a 100-point scale: 50% is a passing grade, while 90% and above is rare. An honor student must obtain a weighted average of 70%, while a high honors students must obtain 85%. Both distinctions are determined by end-of-semester results



#### Izmir

Known throughout the millennia as the "Pearl of the Aegean," the city of Izmir is the cultural, commercial and industrial center of Turkey's Aegean Coast.

Home to a population of four million, Izmir is situated on a beautiful, large bay surrounded by mountains, only 90 km away from Cesme, a famous coastal town, and the ancient Ephesus archeological site, which housed one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

With settlements dating back to 3000 BC, and once home to Homer, Izmir has grown through the ages to become a city of old and new. Home to nine universities, multiple museums, historical, cultural and entertainment sites, Izmir's pivotal location offers connections by air to over 20 European cities. Izmir's modern Adnan Menderes Airport is only an hour flight from Istanbul.

The Turkish Science track contains course work equivalent to AP courses in Calculus BC, Biology, Chemistry and Physics C.

All three Turkish tracks include an academic emphasis on English language instruction.

IB Diploma students are also enrolled in Theory of Knowledge for two hours per week. The International English Language Test is administered in Grade 11.
